

## **Case Log System Changes 2008-2009**

As previously announced, ([http://www.acgme.org/acWebsite/RRC\\_220/DataMemo\\_OB\\_ED\\_7-08.pdf](http://www.acgme.org/acWebsite/RRC_220/DataMemo_OB_ED_7-08.pdf)), the Residency Review Committee (RRC) for Obstetrics and Gynecology has made a number of changes to the Resident Case Log System. With the 2007-2008 academic year data now finalized, the Case Log System will be updated on Tuesday October 14, 2008 to reflect these changes.

If your residents use the handheld version of the software, they need to synchronize with the website prior to the morning of October 14<sup>th</sup> to make the transition easier. By doing so, they will ensure that any data entered on their handheld has been transferred over to the website. The residents should not enter any data on their handheld until we have completed the update. Once it has been completed, the residents need to synchronize with the website again. This second synchronization ensures that the handheld version of the software will be updated to reflect the changes. It is important that residents don't enter any data until the second synchronization since it may cause data conflicts otherwise.

After the update, the ability to add primary and preventive care entries will be removed from the System. Existing primary and preventive care entries will remain, but it will not be possible to make changes or add more. An additional role for teaching assistant will also be added to the list of choices for resident role. Finally, for the codes added to the procedural categories, any existing data entered by your residents will be updated to reflect the proper category.

The 2007-2008 graduates' data is posted in the Accreditation Data System (ADS). You can log into ADS to retrieve the reports for this year's graduates as well as for prior years. Simply choose "Case Log Reports" on the left hand navigation bar after logging into ADS.
