Jerry Vasilius, PhD, began his ACGME career in 1994, and has been the executive director for the Review Committee for Internal Medicine since May 2010. He previously worked in the ACGME Department of Field Activities as Associate Director, Field Staff Activities; and as a senior research associate at the ACGME. Dr. Vasilius developed a symposium for safety net hospitals in 2004 and contributed to the production of a comprehensive frequently asked question (FAQ) document for the Program Letters of Agreement in 2005. He is an administrative advisor to the ACGME Council of Review Committees' Medical Section, and a member of the Department of Accreditation Committees Data

Analysis, Case Log Reporting Focus Group, and Communications and Presentations Focus Group. Dr. Vasilius earned his PhD in applied social psychology from Loyola University Chicago, where he also earned his MA in applied social psychology, and his BA in psychology and philosophy.
