

## Call for Nominations for a Resident Member of the JGME Editorial Board

The [Journal of Graduate Medical Education](#) (JGME) is seeking a senior resident or fellow to serve as the resident member on its Editorial Board.

The Journal:

- Communicates new evidence about graduate medical education (GME);
- Informs and engages the GME community to increase knowledge about teaching and learning;
- Promotes scholarship and critical inquiry related to graduate medical education.

Qualified candidates should have:

- An interest in academic publishing;
- Excellent writing skills and potentially some editing skills;
- The time to handle co-assignment of up to 3 manuscripts annually and participate in quarterly conference calls and 1 to 2 annual face to face meetings (fall and potentially spring).

The term of appointment is 2 years, and candidates should have 2 years remaining in residency or fellowship training. The appointment would begin immediately after selecting a qualified candidate.

The [JGME Editorial Board](#) is made up of 12 medical educators, program directors, and designated institutional officials representing a range of institutions and specialties.

The deadline for receipt of nomination materials is Friday, December 2, 2011.
