



## ACGME RESIDENT CASE LOG SYSTEM MARCH 2012 UPDATE

A new interface for the Resident Case Log System has been developed and is now available for all specialties. It can be accessed via the following link:

Please note:

- We encourage all programs and residents to start using this new interface as the old version will eventually be deactivated. We will notify programs when this occurs.
- This is a fully operational production environment. All data previously entered is accessible for editing and/or reporting in the new interface.

Features of the new system include:

- Favorites (only for specialties using CPT and/or ICD9 codes for entry): the most commonly entered codes across the specialty; program and individual resident are now listed. In addition, residents and administrators can create custom lists of codes for easy and quick reference/logging.
- Cleaner Look/Functionality: the tabs formerly used have been replaced by a menu bar on the left side for better viewability and multitasking. Screen layout and functionality has also undergone refinements for smoother interface processing.
- For specialties using defined categories, it is now possible to search for a code based on the defined category.

The ACGME is currently in the process of designing an iPhone app for the Resident Case Log System. Until this becomes available, a mobile website has been created and is available for use. Due to the unique data collection features, the mobile website is not available for anesthesia, radiation oncology, and diagnostic radiology.
